Raincoast Research Society is dedicated to doing the science we need to maintain our coast as a healthy salmon-forest. RRS has operated on total revenues of \$627,683 from years 2000 to 2008\*. With this, we have run research projects resulting in eighteen published scientific papers. We helped launch Salmon Coast Field Station, which is now a stand-alone entity. We continued recording whale and dolphin occurrence in the Broughton Archipelago and launched the field of salmon aquaculture research in BC, co-publishing with universities across Canada.
